

Last weekend the Sinagua High Mustangs took on the track at Queen Creek. **Alexandra Myers** and **Becca Gazar** worked together and lead the field through the halfway mark of the 1600m run. It was then that Becca upped the ante` and put some mustard on the pace. Her teammate followed suit.



Eventual winner **Alexandra Myers** hit another personal record for the season with a 5:21.37 (which puts her at #3 on the Sinagua all-time 1600m run list.) Since the start of the season **Miss Myers** has posted personal records in the 400m, 800m and 1600m. This is the third time she has eclipsed her own mark in the 1600m event.



Becca Gazar, notorious for making races happen and showing a sheer display of guts also hit a personal record with a time of 5:36.24 in the 1600m. This is the 2nd time this season she has bettered her mark in the distance. So far this year her personal records have fallen in the 3200m and 1600m.



Dillin Hatch took note to his teammates and through a gutsy race and 'never say die' attitude the young **Hatch** was born anew with a personal record of 4:51.36. The young lad from the Northland was still not satisfied and pursued yet another gain in status with a personal record in the 800m of 2:12.54.



Brian Shrader - put in remarkable performances in the 800m and in his debut of the 3200m. He posted his 3rd 800m in the 1:57 range- this time posting a 1:57.51 which is a mere .01 from his own personal record. The young man put down a Vegas style bet in running the 3200m 'the hard way'. He was able to post a 9:43.96.
